ELPHINSTONE LARGE EXTENDABLE POLE TRAILER

PROCEDURE TO LOCK AND UNLOCK TURNTABLE

 Turntable lock pin in locked position (required when running empty and whilst loading

MUST BE REMOVED WHEN LOADED



2. Remove lock pin

3. Place in holder

4. When towing empty pole is shortened



and locked. Cables hooked up on holder (see separate section for extending pole)

Note – plumbing has changed and is now encased rather than the coil configuration shown

PROCEDURE TO EXTEND POLE

1. Unhook safety chain



2. Hook safety chain onto it's holder




3. Use winch handle located on side of A Frame






- 4. Remove safety pins. Unlock locking bolts (2) on front of pole carrier
- 5. Pull out to desired length



As unit turns corners it must have at least 1100 mm free travel it can extend

If carting long poles pull this section out to full length.





Note – original plumbing

When needs to go out long -

Pull main large section pole out until cap on rear end locates in rear of pole carrier

Lock to locking bolts and refit safety pins





Unlock locking bolts in section two and pull out






Note – original plumbing



Plumbing now encased





Need to leave spare cable at front as pole extends when turning corners



When at full length add in inter-connection cable and lash to pole







LONG VEHICLE SIGN

Fold **UP** LONG VEHICLE sign on rear of trailer when trailer is shortened



Fold **DOWN** LONG VEHICLE sign on rear of trailer when trailer is extended








OPERATION OF LANDING LEG



1. In travel position



- **2.** Take weight off leg. Undo locating chain from slot
- **3.** Fold leg down to vertical position



When on ground release lever and allow pins to lock

Be careful as extension is spring loaded.

5. With handle, wind leg down to lift draw bar.





Use reverse procedure to store.

BE VERY CAREFUL WHEN RELEASING LOCKS TO RETRACT EXTENSION AS IT IS SPRING LOADED.
PUT FOOT ON BASE PLATE, RELEASE LOCK AND ALLOW TO RISE SLOWLY




STRAPPING DOWN POLES

Put two straps over at each bolster











IF ONLY CARTING ONE POLE PLACE IN CENTRE AND STRAP DOWN WITH WINCHES ON DOLLY BOLSTERS (EXTENSIONS)





AIR OPERATED WINCHES
